About the College

The spread of European education in alliance with the doctrine of Christianity had been an important impetus to missionary enterprise in India in the nineteenth century. Scottish Church College, established in 1830 as the General Assembly's Institution and given its present name in 1929 is an institution born out of one such impetus.

The college founder, Rev. Alexander Duff, was the first missionary to India from the Church of Scotland. His idea was to set up an institution which linked western education with Christian mission and the eventual progress of the people -- years later the College is committed to the vision of its founding father and aims at academic excellence alongwith social awareness and character building.

The College is the second oldest in North Calcutta and has produced numerous outstanding people, chief among them being Swami Vivekananda and Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose. The college also enjoys the status of College with Potential for Excellence, a quality rating by the University Grants Commission. Media survey rates Scottish as one among the top fifty colleges in India.

The College is now owned and administered by the Church of North India (CNI) through the diocese of Calcutta. It is affiliated to the University of Calcutta but enjoys autonomous status for its Faculty of Post Graduate Studies. We offer Honours course in 15 subjects in the under-graduate stream and post-graduate course in two subjects. The Department of Teacher Education of the college prepares women students for the Bachelor of Education degree.

In keeping with the vision of its founder, the Scottish Church College encouraged academic excellence as well as promoting personality development, community service and the refinement of aesthetic sensibilities. Through the years a long line of illustrious personalities have been educated in these hallowed halls of learning. The splendorous architecture of the College including its magnificent prayer hall is eloquent testimony to its timeless heritage and the pioneering vision of its founding fathers.

- 17)**"World Wildlife Day"** was observed by our Nature Club through a visit to our Fishing Cat and other animals and birds as an awareness towards nature at the Zoological Gardens on 3rd March, 2023.
- 18)"Women's Movements Histories and Narratives : Revisiting the Journey" A day-long State Level Seminar organized by Scottish Church College Women & Gender Cell and IQAC in collaboration with Departments of Political Science, Philosophy, History and Teacher Education. Resource Persons in the programme were Dr. Purabi Roy, Former Prof. IR, JU and Dr. Malini Bhattacharya, Former Professor of English, JU & Former Director of Women's Studies. This was held on 16th March, 2023.
- 19)**"Analysis & Impact of Union Budget 2023"** was organized by Department of Business Management in collaboration with The Institute of Cost Accountants of

India on 15th March, 2023. The Chief Guest in the Programme was Dr. Shiladitya Chatterjee, Ex-IAS, Secretary to "Ministry of Finance", Govt. of Assam Ex-Advisor, World Bank Advisor, Govt. of Assam and Resource Persons were CMA Dr. Timir Baran Chatterjee, Practicing Cost Accountant and CMA Debasis Ghosh, Vice President -Group Indirect Tax and Shared Services, Peerless General Finance & Investment Co. Ltd.

- 20)**The Annual College Picnic** was organized by Teachers' Council and held on 5th February, 2023.
- 21)**The Annual College Former Students' Association Picnic** was held in the college premises on 26th February, 2023. This event received an overwhelming response. Around 300 former students gathered together on this occasion.
- 22)**The College Annual Prize Distribution Ceremony 2022-23** was held on 25th March, 2023 where Prizes and Awards of different departments were given to recipients from the years 2017 to 2020. A special award was given to Dr. Mausumi Manna for her extraordinary contribution towards Social and Community work on behalf of Scottish Church College. The Award was donated through an endowment by Bhaktivedanta Research Centre in the name of Srila A. C. Prabhupada who is one of our renowned alumni (1916-1920). A special felicitation was also offered to Mr. Sayantan Das, who has become the 11th Grandmaster in Chess from Bengal and 81st from India recently.

X. OTHER IMPORTANT MATTERS

- a) **National Education Policy (NEP)** –The Higher Education Department, Govt. of West Bengal has notified that Colleges should follow the policy from the forthcoming academic year. In this respect an IMC was held in the college on 18th March, 2023 to discuss the details pertaining to infrastructure, manpower etc.
- b) College Autonomous A sub-committee meeting (formed in the last Council Meeting held on 18th November, 2022) was called in the college on 27th February, 2023 to discuss the parameters that need to be addressed to move forward in the matter. However, this had to be postponed as the experts and outsiders were absent. A visit by the Principal and IQAC Co-ordinator in early March 2023 to Salesian College, Siliguri & Sonada was undertaken to find out and discuss the modalities followed for autonomous status received by them.

- c) **Opening of Honours Courses** -Higher Education Council has instructed us to provide an affidavit regarding the appointment of further faculty in these departments. This will only be the responsibility of the College. In this regard resolution to be taken.
- d) **Grants** The college is preparing to apply for grants like RUSA 2, DST-FIST Grants and DBT Star College Grant. The newly constituted Research & Development Centre of Scottish Church College will have to take a leading role in these ventures.
- e) **80G** Has been received for issuing receipts to donors for availing exemption of I.T. under Sec. 80G.
- f) **Remodelling Ogilvie Hostel** The project is in progress. For construction purpose a fund is to be allocated which will be approx. Rs. 3 crores.
- g) Installation of Solar Panels The work is in progress
- h) **Digitization of Old & Rare Books** It is to be acknowledged with gratitude that the College has received an amount of Rs. 5 lakh from Bishop's discretionary fund, Calcutta Diocese. The work is in progress.

XI. PROPOSALS:

- A) **Two awards for outstanding faculty members from Humanities, Science and Social Science** on the basis of :
 - i. Research & Publication
 - ii. Awards received from national and international levels
 - iii. Supervisors for Ph.D scholars
 - iv. Teaching experience in and out of the college

A Sub Committee to be formed to decide on the recipients from among faculty for awards for outstanding performance from Humanities, Science and Social Science. Recommendations will be forwarded to the Principal on which the committee will decide and final decision will be that of the committee.

- B) **Guest House Renovation& Meeting Room** the college has collected (Bills of Quantity) BOQ for remodelling of the Staff Quarters in No. 2 campus to convert it into a guest house to accommodate visiting faculty and students on exchange programmes. Senatus' Report will present the amounts.
- C) **Installation of Pollution and Weather Indicator Board** This is proposed keeping in mind awareness and to monitor the air pollution status of the campus and the neighbouring society at large .
- D) **College with Potential for Excellence (CPE)** As CPE 1 has been completed, the college can apply for CPE 2.
- E) **Certificate Courses** Biodiversity & Wildlife; GST, Spanish, French & Sanskrit Language; Instrumentation Training; Entrepreneurship training on cultivation and mushroom & vermin composting; Management Entrance Test Preparation (METP) and a few others were carried in this session. It is proposed to take a fee of Rs. 2,000/- at the time of admission from each student to help them to participate in any one of the given certificate courses.
- F) **Concession** A concession to be provided for students who were not allowed in the Final Semester Examination due to low percentage of attendance when they take admission in the respective semesters.

- G) **College Magazine** It is proposed that the printing cost of the college magazine (only one) be raised from Rs. 75/- to Rs. 150/- from the coming session.
- H) **NEP** -To find out steps to be taken regarding implementation of NEP from the coming session, a committee to be formed immediately.
- Duff College -The Bicentenary of the College will be observed in 2030. The College in association with the Former Students' Association want to set up a second campus at Duff College which was handed over to authority in 1929 and after that it became a police station. At present the structure is standing in a dilapidated condition and not in use.
