
Report on Faculty Development Programme for Young Faculty of Colleges and Universities from 11.04.2023-15.04.2023, Organised by St. Christopher's College of Education (Autonomous), Chennai, Sponsored by United Board for Christian Higher Education in Asia.



Two Faculty members Dr. Varbi Roy, Associate Professor, Department of Philosophy and Dr. Riddhi Bhattacharya, Assistant Professor, Department of History of Scottish Church College were invited as resource persons for the 5-day international Faculty Development workshop for young faculties of universities and colleges at St. Christopher's College of Education Universities from 11.04.2023-15.04.2023 which was sponsored by United Board for Christian Higher Education in Asia.

77 faculty members from universities and colleges from different parts of India and Sri Lanka participated in this workshop. The workshop was meant to train faculty members about the various pedagogical aspects required to equip the new generation Z for their future. The workshop focussed on active learning techniques, outcome-based education, providing effective assessment and feedback etc.





The Faculty Members Dr. Varbi Roy and Dr. Riddhi Bhattacharya, delivered sessions on Backward Design, Universal Design for learning and Teaching Philosophy. They also acted as mentees to faculty members and regularly sat in sessions guiding them to present their learning that they received at the workshop, clearing their doubts and ultimately help them create their teaching portfolio.





This was a very rewarding experience for both the faculty members and this was the second such workshop that they attended as resource persons. Last year the same institution and sponsoring agency organised such a five day workshop from 11.7.2022-17.7.2022, at Chennai as well.
