M.Sc. (Wildlife Science) - Bachelor's degree in Sciences/ Anthropology/ Veterinary/ Agriculture and Allied Sciences/ Geography and Allied Subjects/ Social Sciences/ Engineering (min. 50%) & 10 + 2 (min. 50%). Candidates appearing for final year/semester examinations can also apply.

Ph.D. in Wildlife Science - Candidates having PG Degree in Wildlife Science/ Forestry/ Environmental Science/ M.V.Sc./ M.A. (Sociology/ Anthropology)/ Biodiversity Studies & Management from any accredited Indian or foreign university with a minimum of 55% marks or equivalent grade.

Ph.D. in Forestry - Candidates having PG Degree in Forestry/ Botany/ Environmental Science or related discipline from any accredited Indian or foreign university with a minimum of 55% marks or equivalent grade.
